<input type="checkbox"/>	<a href="#">Biblioteca del Senato</a>	Italian law and the legal systems of other countries, history, science, political and social doctrine, economy. Important collections relating to the fascist period, collections of periodicals published in the 19th century, collections of rare and antiquarian books (from the 15th to the 19th centuries) and the Kasner collection (consisting of 2000 books and engravings of Rome printed between the 16th and the 19th centuries).
<input type="checkbox"/>	<a href="#">Deutsches Archäologisches Institut Rom</a>	Archaeology of Mediterranean countries, classical philology, ancient history, archaeology of the roman provinces, archaeology of the Middle East and Egyptology. Also, the "Bibliotheca Platneriana", a collection of texts focused on the history of Italian cities.
<input type="checkbox"/>	<a href="#">Ecole Française de Rome - Centre J. Bérard de Naples</a>	Archaeology and history of the Mediterranean world (texts dealing with both archaeology and philology), history of medieval Italy, patristics, history of religion and various aspects of French history. Collections in ancient roman and medieval law (Eduardo Volterra Collection). The library of the Centre J. Bérard specializes in archaeological research on Magna Grecia and Sicily. Especially important is the Georges Vallet collection.
<input type="checkbox"/>	<a href="#">John Cabot University - Library</a>	History of art, business economics, classical studies, communications, economy and finance, English literature, international affairs, Italian studies, history, marketing and political science. The Frohring Library consists of more than 20,000 volumes with English, German, Italian, Spanish, French, and Latin titles.
